Implicit Bias: How to Discover Our Innate Truths

Tuesday, June 25, 2024

In 2021 the Academy introduced "Conversations that Matter," a series of Zoom sessions that focused on a white paper written by Academy member Jamie Sabbach. Attendees rated those conversations as one of the most impactful events the Academy offered its members. Since then, the Academy held additional conversations in 2022 and 2023.

Conversations that Matter is for members to discuss critical topics of the day.

These conversations are not instructional other than sharing one's ideas and thoughts; there is no "teacher."
