The Academy's Externship Program enables outstanding young professionals 35 years of age and younger in the parks and recreation field to interact with and learn from American Academy for Park and Recreation Administration members, and other individuals who attend the NRPA Conference and its associated meetings. Up to four Externs are selected each year, two of which are Ernest T. Atwell diversity externs.

Externs are paired with Academy members who serve as mentors during the NRPA Conference as well as past externs who serve as buddies and assist in making the most out of the experience.

Externs may attend selected NRPA Conference meetings, socials, and educational sessions with their mentors or on their own. Mentors introduce Externs to their contacts and expand the young

Eligible applicants should submit an application form and supporting materials on-line no later than **Friday**, **May 3, 2024 (12 midnight PT).**

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must be a current member of NRPA.
- Must be 35 years of age and younger *, with a degree in parks and recreation or a related field.
- At least three (3) years of full-time experience in the parks
 and recreation field, or parks and recreation academia. Must be a full time employee at an agency.
- Current position of at least the specialist or coordinator level with responsibility for program planning, administration, or supervision; or doctoral student.
- Involvement with state, regional and/or national park and recreation associations/ societies, and related field organizations.
- Professional certification is preferred e.g., Certified Park and Recreation Professional (CPRP) or Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist (CTRS) or be a certified/ registered professional under an approved certification/credentialing program.
- Previous Academy Externs are not eligible.
- *Age as of the closing day of the NRPA Conference
