Nominations are now being accepted for the 2019 "Pottsie" Leadership Development Scholarship, which honors the American Academy for Park and Recreation Administration's former Executive Director, John C. The scholarship is intended to support young professionals who have demonstrated leadership and management potential within their organizations, but do not have the financial resources to apply to the Directors School.
